

1. Content: All content and discussions must be appropriate for a general audience and must not contain any offensive, discriminatory, or defamatory language.
2. No music: Pulse Talk Radio is a talk radio station, therefore no music will be played during live shows.
3. Respectful behavior: All presenters must conduct themselves in a respectful manner towards their co-hosts, guests, and listeners.
4. No promotion: Presenters are not allowed to promote their own businesses or products during their shows unless pre-approved by Pulse Talk Radio management.
5. Accuracy: Presenters must ensure that all information shared on air is factually accurate and from reliable sources.
6. Timekeeping: Presenters must adhere to their scheduled show times and must not exceed their allotted time without prior approval from the station.
7. Advertisements and sponsorships: All advertisements and sponsorships must be pre-approved by Pulse Talk Radio management and must be clearly stated as such during the show.
8. Copyright: Presenters must not use copyrighted material without permission or proper attribution.
9. Compliance with laws: Presenters must comply with all applicable laws and regulations, including those related to broadcasting and media.
10. Indemnification: Presenters are responsible for their own actions and content shared on air, and must indemnify Pulse Talk Radio from any legal action resulting from their actions or content.
